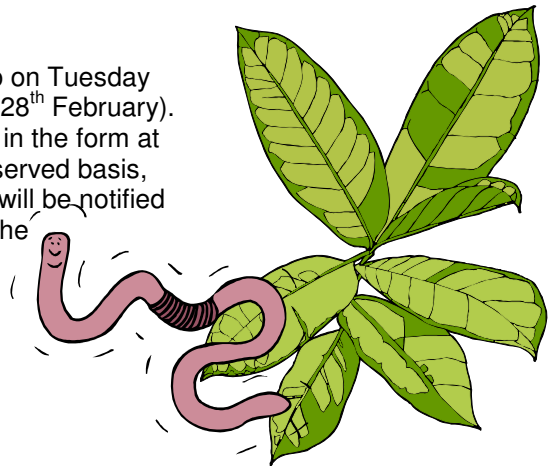
Spring Term Parental Consultations

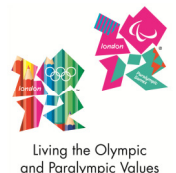
